
Watauga County, NC 2015 Tourism Economic Fact Sheet

Yearly 2015 Tourist Activity in the County

- Generated \$231.44 million per year in direct tourist spending
- Produced **\$52.24 million** per year in worker income & paychecks
- Created **\$9.03 million** per year in local county tax revenues
- Created \$11.61 million per year in state tax revenue
- Generated \$20.64 million per year in combined state & local taxes
- Generated **2,640 jobs** per year
- 2015 Tourist spending increased by 2.5% over 2014

On an Average Day in 2015

Tourist Spending in Watauga County:

- Generated \$56,547 daily in combined state & local tax revenues
- Created **\$24,739** daily in local county tax revenues
- Created \$31,808 daily in state tax revenues
- Generated \$143,123 daily in worker paychecks

2015 Tourism Tax Relief on County Households As a result of taxes generated by tourist spending in Watauga County...

Each of the 33,130 Watauga County households pay \$623 less in local and state taxes. In other words, if tourism did not exist, each household would have to pay \$623 more in state and local taxes to replace the taxes generated by tourist spending.
